

ADVANCED INTENSIVE GROUP

In the Intensive Advanced Group the Trainers and Trainer Assistant will be working as therapist a minimum amount of time giving Advanced Intensive participants ample time to work as therapist.

Each member of this group will be assigned a client from within the group to work with in front of the large group and also within the trios. As supervision is a component of this group, as a participant you will be asked to provide supervision for one of your colleagues after his/her work in the group in order to sharpen your theoretical understanding and support your ability to integrate theory with clinical work.

What you miss in this group is as much time as you would have in the Advanced Group and the Basic Group to focus on group process and to view the trainer's and the trainer assistant's work. What you gain is more opportunity to work as therapist.

As with other participants in the Basic and Advanced Groups, you will have an opportunity to have an individual therapist from either the Clinical Practicum or the Trainers Group if you desire. This is another excellent opportunity, not only for therapy, but also to observe another therapist's work over time.

Advanced Intensive Group participants will have the choice of joining one of the four following theory tracks:

1. Basic Gestalt theory
2. Short term treatment issues
3. The therapeutic relationship
4. Clinical Issues
